How Big Are Your Carbon Feet? – The Green Ninja teaches us how to reduce our carbon footprint – follow footprint tips around the



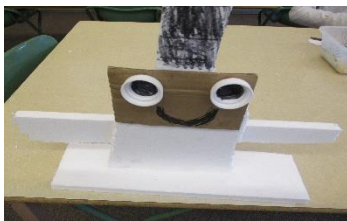
